

Kosmos businesses

Kosmos Korner Store – John Carnahan, 1946-1960; Vic Morrison, 1960-1966; destroyed by fire Aug. 7, 1966.

Bristol's Store and Lockers – Probably M&H General Store in 1953 (Mildred and Hank Stiltner); Lars Phelps had store before Bristol's; Leo and Evelyn Bristol had lockers in 1956, added store in ?

Palorose Café – Kenneth & Elizabeth Barrett had a general store at this location in 1921 when the post office was first located there. It was replaced by the café and adjacent post office in 1940 (Palorose is a combination of Palomino horses and roses, named by the Barretts). Hilda Kristiansen and Anna Baard bought the café in 1956 according to a newspaper story. Gordon (Jug) Hugh advertised it for sale in 1960.

Kosmos Garage – Don Waldo

Circle H Tavern – E.A. and Jeanna Belongia, 1951; news article 1960, Circle H Tavern and service station sold by Mr. & Mrs. John Karksos to Robert Bullinger; Sheriff's sale in 1963, Robert Bullinger; mentioned in Tacoma Power condemnation suit, 1965, Ed and Helen Cheney.

Barrett's Cabins – Kenneth and Elizabeth Barrett; sold to Tacoma by Vic Morrison in 1965.

Shell gas station – "Big Dick" Wierdt, according to a map of the town drawn by John Carnahan, along with the Circle H Tavern.
